Huntington Lake is situated at 7,000 feet in the High Sierras. In June, the daytime high temperature may reach the upper 70's/lower 80's while lows can get down into the 30's. Bring clothing that can be layered, meaning that it can be added/shed according to the temperature and time of day. Thundershowers are possible.

- ☐ 7 PAIR SOCKS
- ☐ 7 PAIR OF UNDERWEAR
- ☐ JACKET (ONE THAT PROVIDES WARMTH AND REPELS RAIN)
- ☐ RAIN JACKET OR PONCHO
- ☐ HAT WITH TIE-ON
- ☐ TENNIS/RUNNING SHOES
- ☐ GOOD HIKING SHOES/BOOTS
- ☐ SLEEPING CLOTHES
- ☐ SWIM SUIT
- ☐ WATER SHOES: EXTRA TENNIS SHOES, *CLOSED TOE* SANDAL, OR WET SUIT BOOTIES
- ☐ POLY "DRY-FAST" SHIRT
